



Westlake Village Symphony Code of Conduct

- WVS seeks to attract members dedicated to providing quality music and concert performances to its audiences. To achieve these goals members should be aware of conduct expected for membership.
- WVS members shall conduct themselves in a courteous and respectful manner at all times during their participation in WVS activities and contact with the public. Reliability and honesty are also expected.
- WVS members agree to be reliable in attendance by consistently showing up to rehearsals, and also by notifying the music director regarding anticipated absences from rehearsals and particular concert cycles when applicable.
- WVS members are not permitted to remove any assets from the control of WVS without permission.
- WVS members are expected to pay the annual membership fee. Exceptions may be made by the Board when deemed appropriate.
- WVS member disputes or disagreements concerning the orchestra must be communicated to the Personnel Director, Music Director, or a board member.
- WVS members must at all times communicate accurate information about WVS to the public and to the media.

Additional Responsibilities of WVS Members

- Assist with set-up and removal of chairs and stands. Take your assigned seat, ensuring that you are allowing adequate space for your colleagues to play their instruments safely and comfortably.
- Each member is responsible to clean up around their area after a rehearsal and concert.
- Following concerts, assist in moving chairs, stands, etc.

Instrument and Player Safety

WVS is not responsible for claims of loss, theft or damage to instruments, cases, or other valuables or personal property. Members assume all risk of any and all such losses or damages.

In order to prevent damage and/or injury, we strongly recommend that players keep the floor clear of instruments and cases. When not being played, instruments should be placed in a safe and secure place.
